4.	The floated PhD topics and a template for writing a research proposal to be shared with the shortlisted candidates	By email	24 <sup>th</sup> April
5.	Candidates are required to choose three PhD topics according to their preference and will write a research proposal on first preferred topic.	By google forms and emails	2 <sup>nd</sup> May
6.	Evaluation of research proposals by supervisors and co-supervisors	Evaluation to be done on 10 point scale for selection in interview. Minimum points set for selection in interview: > <b>or = 8 for GN category</b> > <b>or = 7 for OBC-NC</b> > <b>or = 5 for SC-ST</b> <b>Candidates to be shortlisted for the interview while following reservation norms. The name of shortlisted candidates will be published.</b>	8 <sup>th</sup> May
7.	The candidates selected for interview are required to share their Masters' dissertation report and 5 slides on research proposal	Google forms	11 <sup>th</sup> May
8.	Final Interviews for selection by a committee.
